

Admission of Lanzhou Jiaotong University for Self-financed International Students

1. Admission Type: Students for Chinese language training or for bachelor's, master's or doctoral degrees

2. Admission Quota: Open

3. Nationality: Open (non-Chinese)

4. Disciplines and Majors:

Chinese language training (beginning and advanced)

All the disciplines and majors authorized to confer degrees

5. Mode of Schooling: Full-time

Length of Schooling:

Bachelor's degrees: 4-5 years;

Master's degrees: 3-4 years;

Doctoral degrees: 3-4 years

6. Expenses:

1. Tuition fee:

1) Chinese language training programme: 10,000 Yuan/academic year

2) Bachelor's degree programmes:

Liberal arts: 12,000yuan/academic year

Science: 14,000yuan/academic year

Programmes given in English:

Liberal arts:20,000yuan/academic year

Science: 22,000yuan/academic year

3) Master's degree programmes:

Liberal arts: 18,000yuan/academic year

Science: 20,000yuan/academic year

Programmes given in English:

Liberal arts: 25,000yuan/academic year

Science: 29,000yuan/academic year

4) Doctoral degree programmes:

Liberal arts: 22,000yuan/academic year

Science: 24,000yuan/academic year

Programmes given in English:

Liberal arts: 32,000yuan/academic year

Science: 37,000yuan/academic year

2. Accommodation fee:

1) Apartment shared by 4 students (2 bedrooms, 2 beds in each bedroom, 1 living room, kitchen space, 1 toilet, 1 bathroom with 24 hours hot water). 500 yuan/month/person

- 2) Single room (1 bedroom with a single bed, kitchen space, 1 toilet and bathroom with 24 hours hot water) for doctoral students only: 800yuan/ month/person
3. Textbooks costs and living expenses:
Different personally. around 300-500yuan/academic year for textbooks;
500-1,000yuan/moth for living expenses.
4. Registration fee:
400yuan/year/person

7. Eligibility

- 1) The applicant must be non-Chinese with a valid passport;
- 2) The applicant must be in good health;
- 3) The applicant must have no criminal record
- 4) Requirement to Educational Background and Age:
 - The applicant for Chinese language training must be over 17 years old
 - The applicant for a bachelor's degree programme must be over 18 years old and must have a high school graduation certification;
 - The applicant for a master's degree programme must be over 18 years old and must have a bachelor's degree;
 - The applicant for a doctoral degree programme must be over 18 years old and must have a master's degree;
- 6) An effective HSK certificate (level 3 or above) is required for an applicant for the degree programme. Those who have no this certificate must attend a one-year Chinese training programme before starting their majors.

8. Application Materials

The following materials are needed (2 copies for each):

- 1) *Application Form for International students* filled in Chinese or in English, available at <http://sie.lzjtu.edu.cn>.
- 2) Highest diploma (notarized scanned version). Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with translations in Chinese or English.
- 3) The applicant for a bachelor's degree should submit high school transcript; the applicant for a master's degree should submit undergraduate transcript; the applicants for a doctoral degree should submit postgraduate transcript. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with translations in Chinese or English.
- 4) *Foreigner Physical Examination Form* filled in English. Available at: <http://sie.lzjtu.edu.cn>. The medical examinations must cover all the items listed in the *Foreigner Physical Examination Form*. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid.
- 5) Passport photocopy
- 6) A study or research plan in Chinese or in English.
- 7) The applicant for a master's degree or a doctoral degree must submit two letters of recommendation in Chinese or English by professors or associate professors.

9. Application Deadline:

All the application materials are required to be scanned and submitted by Email and post from Jan. 1st to Dec. 30th.

10. Approval and Notification

LZJTU will organize a committee to review all the application materials, make the decision whether or not to admit the applicants. After that, LZJTU will release the list of matriculated students and send them the Admission Notice of LZJTU and Visa Application for Study in China (i.e.: JW202 Form) for “X” visa application in the Chinese embassy.

10. Visa application:

All the international students matriculated in LZJTU are responsible for their visa application on their own.

11. Enrollment

1. Language training programme:

February 20th – March 10th; September, 1st – October, 31st

2. Degrees programme:

September 1st – 10th

The definite time will be informed on Admission Notice. All the matriculated students should be enrolled in LZJTU on time according to the Admission Notice.
